

C2P2 Early Intervention

The Institute on Disabilities at Temple University is pleased to announce that this year's session of Competence and Confidence: Partners in Policymaking for Families of Children in Early Intervention (C2P2EI) will start in October 2011 and end in April 2012. It will be held in the Pittsburgh area.

What is C2P2EI? C2P2EI is an innovative training program providing family member participants with up-to-date information, leadership development training, resources and skills. Participants learn about the local, state and national issues that affect children with disabilities. Funding for this program is made possible by the Office of Child Development and Early Learning (OCDEL).

Who should apply to C2P2EI? Interested family members throughout Pennsylvania who have an infant, toddler or pre-school age child who has special needs are eligible to apply for this program. Family members must have the desire to learn to advocate for themselves and others and be willing to make a time commitment to attend all four training sessions, which will consist of four 2-day sessions.
